Should meet the following general minimum entrance requirements as stipulated here-under: -

1.1. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION FOR BASIC TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE- NTA LEVEL 4

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with at least four (4) passes in non-religious subjects,

1.2. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION FOR TECHNICIAN - NTA LEVEL 5

Holder of certificate of secondary education examination (CSEE) with at least four passes "D" in non-religious subjects and Holder of NTA level 4 Certificate in Community

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Development, Gender, Project Planning and Management, Record Management, Human Resource Management, Public Administration, Law, Regional Planning, Sociology, Social work or Advanced Certificate of Secondary Examination with One Principal Pass and one Subsidiary Pass

1.3. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION FOR ORDINARY DIPLOMA-NTA LEVEL 6

Holder of certificate of secondary education examination (CSEE) with at least four passes "D" in non-religious subjects and Holder of NTA level 5 Certificate in Community Development, Gender, Project Planning and Management, Record Management, Human Resource Management, Public Administration, Law, Regional Planning, Sociology, Social work.

2.0 MASTERS DEGREE (BLENDED)

The institute currently offer two Blended master Degree programs

- i. Master's Degree in Community Development
- ii. Master's Degree in Project Planning, Monitoring and Evaluation

2.1 ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS REQUIREMENT

The candidate intending to join the Blended master's degree programme at Tengeru Institute of Community Development should have at least one of the following minimum qualifications requirements

- I. At least bachelor's degree lower second for classified award or an average of B grade or credit for unclassified awards on relevant or related fields
- II. At least a bachelors' degree of pass grade with a post graduate diploma on relevant or related field
- III. Holder of advanced diploma in community development, participatory project planning and management and gender and community development

3.0 MODE AND DURATION OF APPLICATION

All applications through the Online Application System (OAS) link:

<https://oas.ticd.ac.tz/login/> or via the Institute's website www.ticd.ac.tz and pay a non-refundable fee of shillings 10,000/= for Tanzanians or USD 40.00 for non-Tanzanians for NTA Level 4,5 & 6. 4

- Applicants who meet minimum entry requirements for Master's Programmes will be required to pay a non-refundable admission processing fee of Tzs. 30,000/= for Tanzanians and 30 USD for Non-Tanzanians.
